Pivoted on the meta-themes of road safety, etiquettes, and road regulation, the ten-day hackathon ends on March 4, 2018.

3 winners will be selected by the Transport Department and facilitated at an event organised by the Government of Maharashtra. The winning games would also be published across platforms with the winner receiving an amount of Rupees 5 Lakh followed by 3 Lakh and 2 Lakh for the first and second runners up respectively.
